

Emmaus Bible Church Conceal Carry Application and Qualification Policy.

- I) The individual must be a member of Emmaus Bible Church and have received the recommendation from the Safety Team leader.
- II) The individual must then have the recommendation of the Deacons.
- III) The individual must possess a valid Nebraska Concealed-Carry Permit (or permit from another state with reciprocity with Nebraska) as well as another form of state/federal ID.
- IV) If the individual meets the above criteria, the Safety Team leader may recommend them to the Elders as a candidate to conceal carry at EBC. The Elders may then interview the individual and approve or disapprove them to start training.
- V) The individual must successfully complete the following courses at 88 Tactical Group or provide proof of successful completion of equivalent training. The equivalent training must teach such things as situational awareness, aggravated environment de-escalation, and speed and accuracy training (waiver authority for equivalent training are the Elders upon recommendation of the Safety Team leader):
- Handgun Course 1
 - Handgun Course 2
 - Intermediate Handgun Defense Level 3
 - Intermediate Active Killer Response
- VI) The Elders will review the certification of successful completion of the prescribed training and may choose to have a follow-up interview with the individual.
- VII) If approved, a document will be issued to the individual from the Elders stating he/she has been given permission to conceal-carry on church property. It is EBC's policy that the individual must carry this document on their person at all times when carrying on church property.
- VIII) The Elder Board may revoke a member's authorization to carry, for any reason.
